Introducing Mumbai in our winter 2017 Cargo network

Schiphol, 16 May 2017 - Air France KLM Martinair Cargo will add a new Indian destination to its worldwide cargo network as KLM Royal Dutch Airlines is launching a direct service from Schiphol – Amsterdam to India's largest city, Mumbai, effective 29 October 2017.

"By introducing Mumbai, the economic heart of India, to our schedule from Schiphol we are able to further increase our already existing network presence in India. Together with our flights operated from Paris Charles de Gaulle we will offer the market a total of 28 services to/from the Indian subcontinent."

Flight schedule: Amsterdam-Mumbai-Amsterdam

During the 2017-2018 winter season, KLM will operate three weekly flights to Mumbai, departing on Mondays, Thursdays and Sundays. All flights will be operated with a Boeing 787-9 Dreamliner, offering a belly cargo capacity between 15 – 20 tonnes.

The flight will depart from Amsterdam at 13:00 hours CET, arriving in Mumbai at 01.55 hours local time. The return flight will depart from Mumbai at 04:00 hours local time, arriving in Amsterdam at 08:45 hours CET.

Mumbai is the capital of the Indian state of Maharashtra and is the most densely populated city in India. Mumbai is situated on the west coast of India and has a deep natural harbour. The city is the financial, commercial and entertainment capital of India. It is also one of the world's top ten centres of commerce in terms of global financial flow.
